



Gas Shut Off Valve Disclosure

Buyer is advised that municipal codes in the Cities of Los Angeles, Santa Monica, West Hollywood, Culver City, and other localities require the installation of gas shut off valves on all residential property (single family, condominiums, and multi residential) upon transfer of ownership. Buyer must verify such seismic shut off valve has been installed prior to close of escrow.

Buyer's failure to comply with these city ordinances will subject the buyer to the payment of non-compliance fees in addition to other penalties as provided by law.

On the purchase of an individual condominium unit, the ordinances require that shut off valves be installed on all gas piping serving that building. In most cases the shut off valves will have been installed by the HOA of that building.

Additional information can be obtained by contacting the department of building and safety in the respective city.

Toilet Retrofit Disclosure

Buyer and Seller herein acknowledge that the City of Los Angeles ordinance requires that all toilets are to be certified as ultra low flow toilets upon close of escrow. These ordinances apply to all residential and commercial buildings. All non conforming toilets must be replaced prior to close of escrow, and a signed certificate of compliance must be filed with the city.
